Available in two sizes, the C<sup>3</sup> offers a customized fit for even greater comfort.




## Control with C3

When the  $C^3$  is placed on the penis, a urethral occlusion pad presses on the urethra. While this localized pressure prevents the involuntary loss of urine, the flow of blood is unimpeded to assure your safety.

So compact, the C<sup>3</sup> is easy to conceal. The elastic strap holds the device in position, allowing you to go about your daily routine without concern about the C<sup>3</sup> shifting.

## Easy to Use

Here's how it works: Unfasten the strap on a flat device and place your penis through the opening. The foam side should face in and the strap should be on top.



Fold the device towards your body to close it around your penis. (The hinges where the device sticks out should be AWAY from the body and the section with the bump should be underneath your penis.) Position the device an inch or so away from your body before tightening the strap.



## Choose the Size that's Right for You

The C<sup>3</sup> device comes in three sizes. Follow these instructions to determine the size that's right for you:

- 1. Use a flexible tape measure.
- 2. Measure only a non-erect penis.

  For best results, conduct sizing when your body is at room temperature.

  For example, don't conduct the sizing immediately after a shower.
- 3. Wrap the tape measure *around* your penis, one to two inches from the body. (Do not measure the length.)
- 4. When the tape measure is snug around your penis, read the number in inches. Do not pull tightly.
- 5. Use the number of inches around to determine your size before ordering:

  Small = less than 2½ inches (6 cm) around

  Regular = 2½-4 inches (6-10 cm) around

  Large = 4-5½ inches (10-14 cm) around



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
